RENEWAL WEEKEND

The renewal weekend has been our main ministry since 1971. We offer the pastor and church leadership the opportunity to strengthen and renew their people for greater involvement in ministry. Weekends are facilitated by Christian lay people who come to your church at their own expense, providing minimal cost and maximum benefit to your congregation. An LLR weekend is a fun and joyful experience for the entire congregation and consists of three components: a program for adults, a program for teens, and a program for children, all of which take place simultaneously.

Everything we do on a weekend falls into five categories: worship, prayer, sharing our faith stories, small group discussions, and fellowship. We begin on Friday evening with a congregational dinner and conclude Sunday following lunch when the team leaves. The congregation holds a celebration/sharing/evaluation session following Sunday lunch. We include the entire church family which enables everyone to attend, participate, and share the experience together. We provide the leadership and team members to facilitate the entire weekend, and our Weekend Coordinator works very closely with your planning committee during the preparation process.

Results

What can a church expect to happen as a result of a renewal weekend?

1. Deeper commitments to Jesus as Lord and Savior
2. Building Christian community on a deeper, more spiritual level
3. Greater commitment to being involved in lay ministry
4. People being empowered for ministry and emboldened to share their faith with others
5. The launching of new ministries
